

**GUIDELINES FOR PUBLICATION IN THE LEOLETTER OF AWARDS,  
NEW TITLES AND RELATED PHOTOS<sup>1</sup>**

**Awards:**

All awards regularly given by the LCA will be published in the LeoLetter as a matter of course (Top Leo awards, Hall of Fame, Therapy Awards, etc.)

**Titles:**

The LeoLetter will publish all new titles of member dogs in any venue or event which is, at the time the title is acquired, listed as a **“Title Considered for Versatility Awards”** in the Working Dog Program. If the title involved is one issued by an organization other than the AKC, it shall be the responsibility of the member seeking publication to provide the LeoLetter satisfactory proof of the title.

The LeoLetter will publish the names of dogs that have received Leonberger versatility titles, as well as the name of any member who did substantial work with the dog to achieve the title.

**LCA National Specialty:**

The LeoLetter will publish the results of all competitive events occurring during the annual LCA National Specialty event.

**Photographs:**

**Awards and Titles:** The LeoLetter may publish, but is not required to publish, photographs of the recipients of the awards and titles mentioned above. In making the determination to publish or not, it should exercise the same outstanding editorial discretion that it has applied heretofore in determining what photographs to publish.

**LCA National Specialty:** Except as mentioned hereafter, no photograph of any dog not owned or co-owned by an LCA member will be published in the LeoLetter in intentional recognition<sup>2</sup> of any win or placement in any competition held at the annual LCA National Specialty event. The LeoLetter will publish the photographs of the BISS and BOS winners of the LCA National Specialty Show and the LCA Traditional Show. If the BISS winner at such traditional show is owned or co-owned by an LCA member, a photograph of that dog will be published on the Front Cover of the LeoLetter reporting the show. If the BOS

winner at such traditional show is owned or co-owned by an LCA member, a photograph of that dog will be published on the Back Cover of the LeoLetter reporting the show. Photographs of BISS or BOS winners that are not owned or co-owned by LCA members shall be posted in close proximity to the posted results of the show.
