APPLICATION TO HOST AN LCA REGIONAL AKC EVENT

LCA Regional AKC events are those events held under the AKC umbrella by the LCA. Since our LCA Regional Clubs are not licensed to hold AKC events, they must be held by the Parent club only. Individual LCA club members or LCA Regional Clubs may apply to host these events on behalf of the LCA. If approved, the show will be considered an LCA Regional Specialty, and will be covered by the LCA insurance policy. An Independent Specialty is a show held for Leonbergers only. If it is held in conjunction with an All-Breed Cluster it will be considered a Concurrent Specialty and requires a letter of consent from the All-Breed club. For Independent and Concurrent Specialties the AKC requires a minimum of 5 committee members.

Please note that all LCA Regional AKC events will fall under the jurisdiction of the National Events Committee. The NEC Show Chair will manage the application process, act as liaison to the AKC, collaborate with your committee on all matters related to the show including but not limited to trophies, judges, AKC Rules, and may communicate directly with personnel from the hosting club for a cluster event. The local LCA member organizer(s) will report to the NEC Show Chair. All information below is required and necessary in order to properly complete AKC paperwork.

Independent Specialty – A show held for Leonbergers only, held as a stand-alone event, or prior to an All-Breed or Cluster show
Concurrent Specialty – An Independent Specialty held during an All-Breed or Cluster show, but held after Best of Breed for the Regular classes
Designated Specialty – Regular classes at an All-Breed or Cluster show “designated” as a breed specialty
Supported Entry – Regular classes at an All-Breed or Cluster show “supported” by breed fanciers financially, and/or in promotion and attendance
Fun Match – A non-pointed “practice” event for clubs, exhibitors, stewards and judges (open to LCA club members only)
