# QUESTIONNAIRE SAMPLE

by an LCA Breeder contributor with minor modifications

The following questions are being asked of you so that the right puppy and the right placement of each puppy is made by bringing the various requirements of both the puppy and new family into perspective, BEFORE a choice is made. I hope you will agree that the animal's welfare must be my foremost consideration in considering a placement. Please answer the following questions as completely as you can, and return this form when you've finished.

Most puppy inquiries either start with "Do they shed a lot?" (yes, they do) and then "How much?". The purchase price for a puppy from my kennel is \$XXXX.00 with an initial down deposit of \$XXX.00. I realize it is a considerable expense. However, your puppy will have 24-hour personal and if necessary medical care and attention for the first 9-10 weeks of its life including first training and socialization and vet visits. I will also process and complete the AKC puppy registration for you. No action is necessary from your side. You will have access to the puppies after they are 3-4 weeks old and visits are encouraged. You will be showered continuously with pictures and updates on the progress of these puppies. The puppies will be introduced to visuals, sounds, dogs, humans, crates and down pillows, blankets and toys, inside and outside life, and after it has had its first shots it will travel in the car in crates or travel bags to various places with me and it will be introduced to a variety of different foods from raw to cooked to kibble food. The puppies' well-being and new life is and will continue to be of utmost importance to me. I have to be convinced to have found the puppy's best new home before I let it go or bring it there myself. I stay in very close contact with all my puppy families and remain available 24/7 for any questions. It is also important for a new Puppy Buyer to be aware that after the initial expense there will continue to be a fairly high cost to owning a Leonberger; food, training, boarding, potential house and car repairs and clothing replacements and of course medical bills. Medical bills for a puppy of this size and this breed are exponentially higher than for a smaller dog. It can easily add costs to your monthly budget. You need to be prepared for medical disaster bills of up to and beyond \$5000 for accidents or illnesses which could be covered by insurance if you have it, but it still has to be planned for.

Now, if this has not deterred you from still wanting a Leonberger Puppy, could you please answer these preliminary questions for me so I can start to get to know you.

41. Do you understand the difference between a limited registration and a full AKC registration? Puppies from my kennel are usually sold on a limited registration for pets. For puppies moving into a show or breeding home I remain co-owner in the registration so I can assist in any showing/breeding plans. The goal is to keep them in accordance with the Leonberger standard and in mine and the puppy's best interest.

43. Will you consider keeping your dog intact until the growth plates have closed at approx. 18 months to 2 years in the large breed puppies?
44. What kind of food are you feeding your dog(s)? Are you willing to try different types of food? Not all dogs thrive on the same foods. Puppies can be raised with a mix of different brands of kibble, raw and cooked foods.
45. Do you welcome the idea of keeping a fairly close relationship with the breeder for the lifetime of your puppy?

There are no wrong answers. I am just trying to get to know you so that we can match up the right puppy with you and your "situation/lifestyle". Thank you for your honesty. Your comments and questions are always welcome.

## PUPPY CONTRACT SAMPLE

The subject of this sale is one purebred Leonberger puppy, hereinafter referred to as "LEO PUPPY", whose sire & dam are registered with the American Kennel Club.

**TRANSFER:** Seller hereby transfers ownership to Buyer of the Leo Puppy described as follows:

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SALE:

The purchase and sale of this Leo Puppy involves special rights and responsibilities for both the Buyer and the Breeder. Buyer and Breeder agree to these guidelines set henceforth in this contract. Any revisions to the following contract must be noted and initialed by both the Buyer and Breeder.

1. PURCHASE PRICE: Buyer shall pay Breeder \$\_\_\_\_\_ (X THOUSAND ZERO HUNDRED DOLLARS U.S.) total for the purchase of one Leo Puppy to be paid as set forth below.
2. DEPOSIT: \$\_\_\_\_\_
3. PURCHASE PRICE BALANCE: \$\_\_\_\_\_
4. POTENTIAL REFUNDS: Seller will refund owner \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each test result that is submitted to OFA.org for the following health tests and AKC.org for the temperament test listed below. This is applicable for puppies purchased for Buyer's own breeding program purposes. If Seller intends to use the dog for their own breeding purpose, then the refund will not apply. The tests for thyroid, hips & elbows may not be performed before 24 months of age per the LCA Member practices. Eyes need to be tested after 18 months of age.

- OFA or PennHip Hip and Elbow x-rays test results sent to OFA
- OFA Thyroid test results sent to OFA
- ACVO Eye exam test results sent to OFA
- Basic or Advanced Cardiac Eval test results sent to OFA
- CGC (Canine Good Citizen) test results sent to AKC
- Blood draw / test at UMN for LPN1, LPN2, LPPN3, LEMP results sent to OFA

**BUYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES** (each must be initialed before possession of Leo Puppy)

- Buyer agrees to have the Leo Puppy examined by an accredited veterinarian within 72 business hours from the time the Buyer obtains possession of said animal and shall obtain a signed statement from that veterinarian that the animal is in good health. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer).
- If the accredited veterinarian certifies with a signed assessment, that the Leo Puppy is unhealthy, the Buyer may return the Leo Puppy for a full refund of monies paid less a deposit of \$\_\_\_\_\_. If the Buyer chooses to return the said Leo Puppy, Buyer shall pay for any and all veterinary and transportation costs of the animal. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Once the Leo Puppy has left the Seller's possession, the Seller is no longer responsible for death, injury or deformity of this animal due to accident, illness or any deviation from adequate care normally given to a giant breed dog, including but not limited to, proper diet, maintaining proper weight, exercise, grooming, veterinary care, shelter, and protection from abuse or misuse. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Buyer agrees to socialize this Leo Puppy to a variety of sights, experiences, animals, and people, both off and on their property in order to instill confidence and steady temperament until the Leonberger reaches 24 months of age. For this purpose, Buyers agree to enroll the animal in a minimum of three obedience classes (puppy, novice and intermediate class) preferably ending with a certification of the animal as a Canine Good Citizen (CGC). \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Buyer agrees that this Leo Puppy will be a family house pet and will be kept in the home, not be kept in the backyard or outdoor kennel for extended periods. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Buyer agrees that neither this Leo Puppy nor any offspring of this Leo Puppy shall be given to, leased to, or consigned to any commercial pet store, chain store, puppy mill commercial breeding facility or fund-raising raffle. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- If, at any time or for any reason, the Leo Puppy is to be placed with a new family, sold, given away to a humane society, destroyed, or otherwise disposed of, the Seller must be notified before any action is taken. Seller shall have the first option to repossess the Leo Puppy or make other appropriate arrangements. If the Leo Puppy is placed with the Seller's permission, the name, address and contact information of the new owner shall be provided to the Seller and the new owner will be bound by the terms of this contract. In the event of the death of the owner(s) the ownership of this Leo Puppy reverts to the Seller, effective immediately, unless written otherwise in a notarized Will or Trust. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Buyer agrees to furnish updated contact information in the event there is a change of address or phone number. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- If this Leo Puppy dies of unspecified causes, not medically diagnosable as disease or trauma, Buyer shall notify the Breeder within 24 hours so the Breeder may arrange for autopsy, if desired. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)
- Buyer will allow Breeder and/or stud owner or their appointed agent to visit the Leo Puppy at any time, with reasonable notice and that if it is found that any of the aforementioned terms for care and safe keeping of the Leo Puppy are in violation, Sellers or their appointed representative may take possession of the animal without reimbursement. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer).
- Buyer shall not neuter/spay this Leo Puppy before 24 months of age. Buyer agrees that neuter/spay will not take place sooner without the consent of the breeder in order to ensure the puppy's healthy growth and development to its full potential. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)

**BREEDER'S RESPONSIBILITES**

- Breeder agrees to furnish written instructions for care of this Leo Puppy.
- Breeder will supply full medical history of this Leo Puppy.
- Breeder shall replace said Leo Puppy with a puppy from a future breeding, if the said Leo Puppy must be euthanized or is severely limited by the age of eighteen (18) months due to dysplasia or other inherited disease. The rating of dysplasia severity must be provided by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals, Inc (OFA) and proper documentation from an accredited veterinarian is necessary for verification of an inherited disease.
- The Breeder has done all due diligence to ensure the Leo Puppy is bred from quality, healthy, sound temperament Leonbergers, who meet the AKC breed standard and LCA Member Practices set at the time



of breeding. The Breeder has taken every reasonable precaution to ensure physical soundness and mental stability in this breeding and therefore makes no other warranties; Parasites gained after leaving Breeder premises, crating, training, vaccinating, and other variables which may influence the animal's condition once it is in the Buyers possession, which are beyond the Breeder's control, make any further guarantees non-negotiable.

· Breeder strongly recommends the Buyer get pet insurance for the puppy as soon as possible with a health insurance of your choice.

**BREACH OF CONTRACT**

The State of \_\_\_\_\_ shall govern the terms and conditions of this agreement. Violation of any of the provisions outlined above shall result in the repossession of the Leo Puppy by the Seller. In that event, the Buyer shall forfeit any rights to the Leo Puppy and any cash consideration paid to the Sellers except as indicated.

 (Show/Non-Breeding Buyers may stop at 1 since the puppy is not sold as breeding stock)

**BREEDING POTENTIAL PUPPY:** The Seller will choose a puppy that shows good potential as a breeding dog or bitch. The term is not a warranty on the part of the Seller that the dog is "BREEDING QUALITY". It does not guarantee that the Leo Puppy, sold with potential to breed, will develop to have breeding quality. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)

**SHOW/BREEDING POTENTIAL: INTEGRITY AND PROTECTION OF THE BREED.** In order to protect the integrity of the breed, the Buyer agrees to breed the dog only:  
 a) By first becoming an LCA Leonberger Club of America's Member in good standing \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)  
 b) By becoming an LCA registered kennel or raise the pups under the Breeder's kennel per agreed upon contract \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)  
 c) By initially consulting the breeder to carefully select the lines and breeding partners to insure as much as possible a litter according to standard and type of the Leonberger Breed. \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)  
 d) In compliance with the CURRENT Leonberger Club of America's Member Practices \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)  
 e) In keeping with standards set by the AKC official standard as follows on their website <http://images.akc.org/pdf/breeds/standards/Leonberger.pdf> \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)  
 f) With all health clearances done at or after 2 yrs. of age and filed to the appropriate organizations and sent to OFA.org and receive a CHIC number (Canine Health Information Center) \_\_\_\_\_(Buyer)

**4. SHOW/BREEDING POTENTIAL: HEALTH TESTING** The puppy will be sold with a breeding contract with the understanding that breeding will only take place after all health and conditions are met and the temperament of the puppy is still SOUND at 24 months: All health testing costs will be paid by Buyer. These tests must be performed after the age of 2 years. \_\_\_\_\_Bbuyer)  
 a) OFA Hip Dysplasia OR PennHIP cleared

- b) OFA Elbow Dysplasia tested

- e) Cardiac Evaluation: Congenital or Advanced Cardiac exam is normal
- b) AKC OR EQUIVALENT Temperament test passed with no restriction (CGC)
- f) OFA teeth certificate showing no more than 1 tooth other than M3 missing (optional)
- g) DNA Repository (optional)

**5: SHOW/BREEDING POTENTIAL: AGREED UPON FUTURE BREEDINGS**

- A. Male Puppy: If the subject of this agreement is male, Seller agrees to one future breeding with the male for the purpose of breeding said dog to any Leonberger bitch chosen by the seller. Costs for the collecting or breeding incurred will be covered by the Seller/Breeder paid directly to Buyer. However, this does not include Health tests previously agreed upon in this contract. Buyer will receive \$\_\_\_\_\_ US dollars if there are 3 or more puppies born and survive the first week. No other monies or puppies by the breeding are inferred to the Buyer by this agreement.

- B. Female Puppy: If the subject of this agreement is female, Seller agrees to one future breeding with the female for the purpose of breeding said bitch to any Leonberger dog chosen by the Seller. Costs for the breeding incurred will be covered by the Seller/Breeder paid directly to Buyer. However, this does not include Health tests previously agreed upon in this contract. Buyer can choose to receive one puppy back if there are 3 or more puppies born and survive the first week or \$\_\_\_\_\_ US dollars.
